ARMBANDS:

We will not be using armbands at the trial. The running order for the day will be posted at the table. If your dog needs to be measured come early as the dog will need to be measured before he/she runs. If you run without having the measurement done your runs will not be counted.

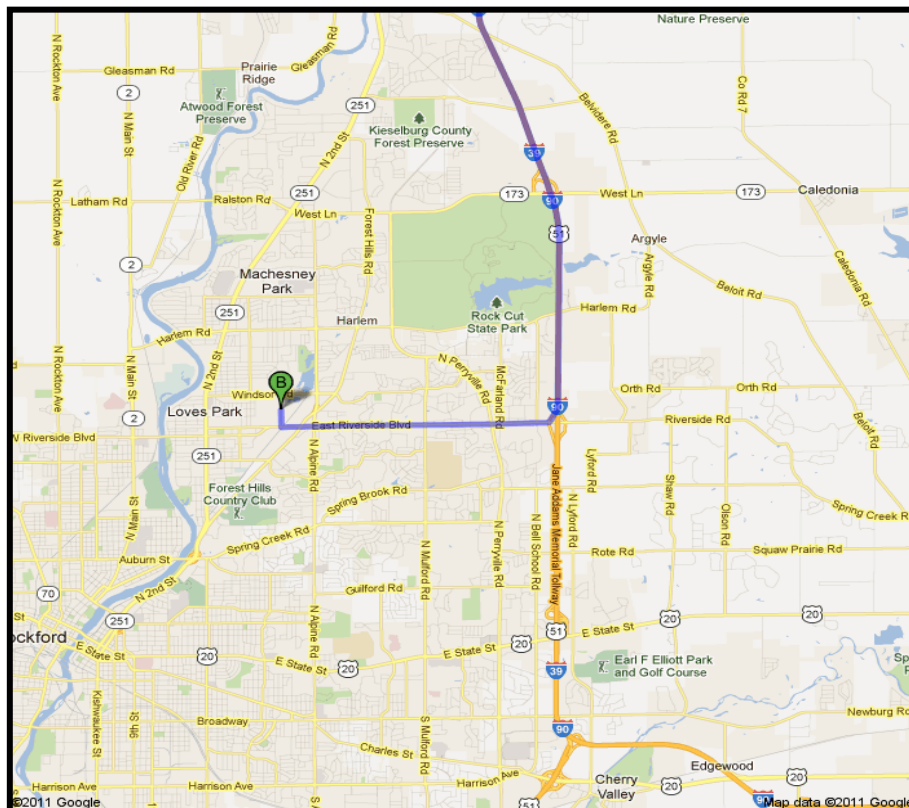
SITE INFORMATION:

From I90/39: Take the E. Riverside Blvd exit. Turn west into E. Riverside Blvd towards town. Turn right onto Material Ave. Forest City Dog Training is in the brown industrial park on the right side of the road.

Masters/Excellent Standard: 36 dogs to follow Novice FAST

Open Standard: 9 dogs to follow Master/Excellent Standard
