

Notice to Exhibitors

Email, Telephone, Fax and Unsigned Entries CANNOT Be Accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms **without** Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Mail All Entries With Fees to: Anne Kaszak, 580 North Nichols Street, Lowell, IN 46356. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practical with tickets and/or identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission and identification before the dog will be received. **Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor** within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary.

Make All Checks and Money Orders payable to WLRC. CANADIAN exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. Funds. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

A Recording Fee of .50 and \$3.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-Giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 14, Section 2.)

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. **A \$25.00 Collection Fee will be charged for ALL returned checks.** Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made, however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry form, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Judges Will Not Wait For Any Dog Holding Up A Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

Class cash prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging is over, and the Show Secretary's Office advised at once. The Show Secretary and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging is over.

Note – Foreign dogs are eligible for Puppy Classes and Open Classes, effective January 1, 1985.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dogs and two of the Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for the breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or some other Non-Regular Class. Stud Dog fee is \$20.00 if entered in Stud Dog only. There is no entry fee if entered as an additional class.

Brood Bitch Class – Same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

NOTE – As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged First in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.
